

AN INFORMATIONAL MTG. will be held at 7 PM ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 11TH In the Copper View Elementary School cafeteria where we will answer any questions you have about the audition process, classes, and our summer youth programs.

Auditions will take place Tuesday January 28th through Thursday January 30th

 $at the Sahuarita\ Primary\ School\ Gymnasium$ (Enter the parking lot by turning on Salome Loop Road at the light. Turning away from Frys)

*Callbacks are by invitation only on Saturday, February 1st 2025 from 3-9 pm

at Copper View Elementary School Gymnasium (Located at 350 W Sahuarita Road off Starlight View Lane. Park by the pool for easiest access)

THOSE AUDITIONING SHOULD COME PREPARED TO SING ONE OF THE SONGS, LISTED IN THE AUDITION PACKET, AND TO LEARN CHOREOGRAPHY.

Be aware that Rehearsals are Thursdays at SPS from 4:30-7pm and Saturdays at Copper View from 3-8pm as called, (with additional Friday evenings from 5-8pm for lead/small group vocals). There is a \$250 production fee that will be due February 27th at our first cast/parent meeting. Performances for this show will be May 29th-31th 2025.

FOR THOSE WHO ARE AUDITIONING: PREPARATION IS ESSENTIAL and plays a HUGE role in our casting decisions. Many incredibly talented young people audition for us. Your audition should reflect the skills and training you have worked to develop. Please arrive on time at Sahuarita Primary School for your audition. Please know your song lyrics, and dress appropriately. This is your opportunity to make a good first impression and to present yourself in a professional manner. Before you sing, please tell us your name, age, and the song you will be singing. If you have not auditioned for us in the past, this is called a slate. *Be aware that vocal auditions are musical monologues. We can tell a lot about your storytelling skills and acting abilities from your vocal audition.

*DO NOT choreograph your vocal audition. . . Instead, move as your character might when telling a story.

*Your audition song **MUST BE ONE OF THE SONGS PRE-SELECTED BELOW**. You are not asked to sing the entire song; only about a minute of the song (also pre-selected). Each song has a couple of YouTube links for you to practice along with, one where you can listen to the original Broadway recording, and one soundtrack that will be used for the audition.

Audition Groups of Twenty will be divided as follows: Ten students will first sing for our judges, then all twenty will learn/perform choreography, followed by the final ten in the group who will sing. (*Please see our dress code for appropriate clothing/shoes for your dance audition. You will be given time to change if needed.*)

<u>CALLBACKS</u>: are by invitation only and will be held on <u>SATURDAY</u>, <u>FEBRUARY 1ST FROM 3-9PM AT COPPER VIEW ELEMENTARY</u>. This is an opportunity for directors to continue making decisions with regards to readiness, and performer compatibility. If you are asked to return for a callback you may be considered for a specific role(s) and the directors need to see you read, or sing with the other characters also being considered. Directors may also choose to callback students they are unfamiliar with and need to see more from before considering casting them in this production. (Please Note: Callbacks do not guarantee participation in our productions, and the lack of a callback does not necessarily mean you have been cut.)

CALLBACK INFORMATION WILL BE SENT OUT VIA EMAIL TO THE EMAIL YOU REGISTERED AND SIGNED UP TO AUDITION WITH NO LATER THAN FRIDAY JANUARY 31ST. If you do not receive an email from us by 5pm on Friday, please contact us at heyproductionsorg@gmail.com.

Casting is influenced by maturity, a script's vocal and theatrical requirements, experience, personality, and the director's vision.

FOR PARENTS: AUDITIONS ARE STRESSFUL FOR EVERYONE! Please, find positive ways to uplift and encourage your child during this process. Let them know that you are proud of them. If they need help, you can assist them in filling out registration forms, picking out appropriate clothing, and submitting music for their audition. Be their biggest fan by supporting them and the other students auditioning with them. Sometimes students will have a bad audition day. It happens to everyone. It is ok to be disappointed. Remember that the directors sometimes see a different audition than the one you might have seen at home. We appreciate your understanding and support when cast lists are announced. If your child is disappointed, encourage them to keep working hard if this is something they want to do and continue setting goals. We do see the growth they are making when they come back and try again.

If you have been cut in the past, what can be done to improve your chances of being cast in the future?

Many students who participate in our productions take dance classes, voice lessons, and are participating in school, church, or local drama programs. If you have never had any musical theater training, begin working to grow your skills. If you get nervous auditioning, practice singing or dancing in front of family and friends, audition for the school talent show, or sing karaoke. All of these things will improve your chances of being cast in future shows.

BEFORE YOU DECIDE TO AUDITION- SOME THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

-Rehearsals will be held at <u>Thursdays from 4:30-7pm at SPS and Saturdays from 3-8pm at Copper View Elementary</u> (<u>With addition vocal rehearsals for leads on some Fridays</u>) <u>beginning Thursday</u>, <u>February 6th</u>, <u>2025</u>. Please check the rehearsal schedule/ google calendar to see if you are called.

*IF YOU WANT TO BE A LEAD IN THIS SHOW

- -We are looking for actors *WHO DO NOT HAVE MULTIPLE CONFLICTS* (*NO MORE THAN 3 PREFERRED*), who work hard, and can handle being given correction.
- -If you are a lead and miss rehearsal for any reason (other than a previously known conflicts or illness/family emergency) you will be given one free pass. If it continues to happen, you will be asked to either understudy the role you were cast in, or you will not be considered for leading roles in upcoming seasonal productions.

*IF YOU WANT TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS SHOW

- -We are looking for people WHO DO NOT HAVE MORE THAN 5 CONFLICTS.
- -If you miss rehearsal for any reason (other than previously known conflicts or illness/family emergency) you will be given one free pass. If it becomes a continuous problem, you will be taken out of scenes you have not learned.

IF STUDENTS HAVE 6+ CONFLICTS, THEY MAY NOT BE CAST IN THIS PRODUCTION REGARDLESS OF SKILL LEVEL OR ABILITY.

*We understand that things come up that you did not know about before auditioning however, **WE NEED THIS SHOW TO BE YOUR PRIORITY!** If you are not able to commit to this show, we ask that you consider auditioning for a future show that better works with your schedule. Absences not recorded on your initial audition contract or excused because of illness or family emergency will be subject to the above stated conditions.

-All Costs associated with this Production will be due in full at our **MANDATORY PERFORMER/PARENT MEETING on Thursday, February 27**th **at 6:30pm** -\$250 per student. If cost is an issue, please talk to Diana Prior or Cindy Robinson. Show fees include: a cast T-shirt, and the costs of participation. Show fees DO NOT include the cost of tickets to attend the show, or any underclothing, shoes or personal items you may be asked to wear as part of your costume.

SPECIFIC AUDITION/REHEARSAL INFORMATION: Participant age is 10-24 years old (when you Audition)

- 1) -Those choosing to audition need to <u>Fill out ALL Audition Registration forms.</u> All forms must be complete and submitted online no later than Thursday, January 30th, 2025.
- 2) Sign up for a Live Audition Group (Vocal and Dance Audition at Sahuarita Primary School) and pay the non-refundable \$10 audition fee. Auditions will take place Tuesday, January 28th through Thursday January 30th.
- 3) Children under 18 years need to have parental consent to audition.

We ask that all cast members attending rehearsal be free of <u>ANY ILLNESS</u> for at least <u>24 hours</u> before returning to rehearsal.

*Dress Code: All students will be asked to wear the following to rehearsal:

Girls: T-shirt, fitted shirt, tank top, or leotard that covers the abdominal area with leggings, biker shorts, or sweatpants (No jeans, crop tops or Baggy Sweatshirts- unless being worn in addition to a shirt for added warmth) Prefer: Black/tan jazz shoes or sneakers.

Boys: T-shirt or fitted tank top -cannot have large openings in arms and must cover the abdominal area with sweatpants, biker shorts or soccer shorts (no jeans or baggy sweatshirts-unless being worn in addition to a shirt for added warmth)

Prefer: Black/tan jazz shoes or sneakers.

HAIR FOR BOTH BOYS AND GIRLS NEEDS TO BE PULLED BACK AND AWAY FROM THE FACE.

*Audition Tip: Know that we are watching you from the time you walk into your audition. If you are unable to focus, are disrespectful to directors or other potential cast members (including siblings), or are talking when potential cast members are auditioning, or after being asked not to talk, we may choose not to cast you in this production.
